

ABOUT CENOVUS



Cenovus's downstream operations include upgrading, refining and marketing operations in Canada and the United States.

THE CENOVUS TOLEDO REFINERY

The Cenovus Toledo Refinery is located in Oregon, Ohio, which is adjacent to the City of Toledo. It has been operating for more than 100 years and can process up to 160,000 barrels of crude oil per day (bbls/d), including 90,000 bbls/d of heavy oil.

The refinery can produce 3.8 million gallons of gasoline, 1.3 million gallons of diesel fuel and 600,000 gallons of jet fuel daily.

The Cenovus Toledo Refinery is located in Oregon, Ohio, adjacent to the City of Toledo.

OREGON, OHIO

The City of Oregon, located east of Toledo is a recreational gateway to Lake Erie, and an industrial suburb. The population of Oregon has grown more than 10% over the last two decades, and the city is often referred to as "Oregon on the Bay," for its location on the western shores of Lake Erie.

Oregon offers a balance of unique lakefront living, recreational opportunities and excellent services for residents. You will find beautiful residential homes in safe neighborhoods near cycling paths and leisure trails that provide quick access to Maumee Bay State Park and Pearson Metropark.

TOLEDO, OHIO

The City of Toledo is located in northwest Ohio, on the western end of Lake Erie. It borders the state of Michigan and is the fourth-most populous city in Ohio.

Toledo has many attractions for visitors and residents, such as the Toledo Museum of Art. Toledo Zoo & Aquarium, Imagination Station, the Toledo Symphony, Toledo Ballet and the National Museum of the Great Lakes. It is also home to the Toledo Mud Hens minor league baseball team and the Toledo Walleye minor league hockey team. Both teams' stadiums are located in downtown Toledo and are the focal point of its growing entertainment district.

- The iconic Jeep originated in Toledo during World War II. Today, the Wrangler and Gladiator are still produced in the area.
- Toledo has one of the most affordable housing markets and is ranked one of the most affordable cities in the country.
- The median sale price of homes in Toledo is ~\$100,000. This is 1/4 of the average home sales price in the United States (~\$420,000).

Realtor.com's 2024 Top Housing Markets forecast named Toledo as the top housing market among the largest 100 markets in the U.S.

ARTS & CULTURE

The Toledo Museum of Art is a must-see for art lovers. Largely considered one of the top 10 art museums in the country, the museum has a diverse collection of art from around the world, with special emphasis on 19th and 20th century European and American paintings. You can also admire the stunning glass artworks in the museum's glass pavilion, which showcases glass objects from ancient times to the present. The museum is free to the public and open Tuesday to Sunday.

National Museum of the Great Lakes

The National Museum of the Great Lakes is a fascinating place to learn about the history and culture of the Maumee River and the Great Lakes. The museum features interactive exhibits, artifacts and stories that tell the history of how the Great Lakes shaped America's development and identity. You can also board the Col. James M. Schoonmaker Museum Ship, a historic freighter that sailed on the Great Lakes for 64 years. The museum is open Tuesday to Sunday.

Toledo Symphony Orchestra

The Toledo Symphony Orchestra is a communitysupported organization of professional musicians and teachers who deliver quality performance and music education for all. The Toledo Symphony reaches more than 260,000 individuals annually through performances and education programs. The series concerts (Masterworks, Pops, Chamber and Family Series) are the critical underpinning of the orchestra's artistic mission and regularly draw people from 135 postal zip codes. Education programs, student performances and community concerts are held in schools, neighborhood churches, performing arts centers and community facilities throughout the region; many are offered at no charge or provided at a reduced fee to help expand participation.



Toledo Ballet

Toledo Ballet inspires the passions and spirit of the Toledo community through dance. Toledo Ballet provides quality dance instruction and exceptional performance opportunities to over 250 students throughout northwest Ohio and southeast Michigan annually. Toledo Ballet students have competed at the national and international level, including the Youth American Grand Prix, the world's largest international student ballet competition, and many have pursued dance professionally at some of the most prestigious ballet institutions in the nation, including New York City Ballet, Chicago Ballet and Cincinnati Ballet.

Toledo Jazz Orchestra

Since 1979, the Toledo Jazz Orchestra has worked with dozens of industry legends, including Dizzy Gillespie, Joe Williams, Clark Terry and Zoot Sims. This 18-member group also performs the works of the major big bands from the past eight decades along with arrangements commissioned specifically for the orchestra. The Toledo Jazz Orchestra has two albums to its credit titled "Groovin" and "Out of Nowhere."

Toledo Alliance for the Performing Arts

On January 1, 2019, the Toledo Ballet and Toledo Symphony officially merged to form the Toledo Alliance for the Performing Arts (TAPA), a non-profit organization dedicated to providing exceptional live music and dance performances and education for the region. TAPA welcomed the Toledo Jazz Orchestra as its third musical entity in 2024. This performing arts merger is one of only a few in the nation and promises to create new and invigorating programs, provide cost and revenue synergies in operations, and integrate the arts through shared educational missions.

HEALTHCARE

Toledo Clinic

The Toledo Clinic is a large multispecialty medical group that offers comprehensive healthcare services. It has multiple locations throughout Toledo and provides specialized care in various fields, including cardiology, dermatology, gastroenterology, orthopedics, urology and more.

University of Toledo Medical Center (UTMC)

UTMC is part of the University of Toledo and serves as an academic medical center. It provides a wide range of medical services, including primary care, specialty care, surgery, cancer care and research. UTMC is affiliated with the University of Toledo College of Medicine and Life Sciences.

Mercy Health

Mercy Health is a Catholic healthcare system that operates Mercy Health – St. Vincent Medical Center in Toledo and Mercy Health – St. Charles Hospital in Oregon, Ohio. St. Vincent Medical Center is a regional referral center providing specialized services such as trauma care, cardiac care, orthopedics and cancer treatment.

Mercy Health also offers primary care, specialty care and outpatient services throughout the Toledo area.
